# **Inter School Quiz on Earthquake Tips**

NICEE conducted an Inter School Quiz competition on *IITK-BMTPC Earthquake Tips*, the final round of which was held on 26 January 2017 at Outreach Auditorium, Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur, Kanpur.

53 schools from 37 cities participated in the preliminary rounds which were held in Ahmedabad, Ghaziabad, Gwalior, Jaipur, Kanpur, Ludhiana, Panchkula and Nagpur. In the final round of the quiz on 26 January, 08 schools-DPS, Agra; DAV, Ludhiana; Police DAV, Patiala; BVB Prism School, Satna; Centre Point School, Wardhman Nagar, Nagpur; Faridabad Model School, Faridabad; Aditya Birla School, Bharuch; and St. Stephen's Senior Secondary School, Ajmer participated.

The quiz had four rounds: Round Robin, Picture Round, Rapid Fire Round and Lucky Number Round. The winning team from DAV Public School, BRS Nagar, Ludhiana scored 83 points. Faridabad Model School, Faridabad and BVB Prism School, Satna came second and third, respectively, scoring 82 points and 80 points. 



During the year 15,590 copies of books, monographs, and CDs, were distributed. Till date, NICEE has distributed 1,69,910 such items.







# **Earthquake Engineering Practice**

With a healthy growth of NICEE activities, the overall expenditure during the year stood at about ₹ 49.96 lakhs (₹ 47.12 lakhs last year). This was covered by a healthy mix of resources from various sources: 45% from sales and fees; and 55% from interest from endowment.

The sale proceeds from publications and monographs were ₹15.32 lakhs as compared to ₹17.43 lakhs last year. The number of donors this year were 82 (47 last year) contributing a total of ₹ 6.44 lakhs with an average donation of ₹7,857/- (₹8.40 lakh last year with average of ₹17,874/-). Since inception, NICEE has received one or more donations from a total of 533 donors with an overall median of ₹ 3,000: this is a great endorsement of NICEE's activities by its friends and well wishers.
