

#### **Workshop for Architecture Students**

The 13th National Workshop for UG students of Architecture was held at IIT Kanpur during August 07- 14, 2021, in which 86 students from Bhutan and 19 institutes representing 15 cities from all over India participated in the 8-day workshop. The participating students had completed six semesters of studies in their respective architecture programmes. The general objective of the workshop was to sensitize the students to earthquake safety issues and capacity building in the basics of earthquake-resistant design at a conceptual level. #### **Inter School Quiz on Earthquake Tips**

NICEE conducted an online Inter School Quiz competition on IITK- BMTPC Earthquake Tips. The final round of which was held on January 26, 2022, at the Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur, Kanpur.

In this competition, more than 800 students registered from eight states: Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Delhi, Rajasthan, Gujrat, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, and Maharashtra, out of which 150 students participated. The quiz consists of twenty multiple-type questions with a maximum time limit of 10 minutes.

The Webinar was conducted at IIT Kanpur on January 26, the anniversary of the 2001 Gujarat earthquake, in which Prof. CVR Murty, IIT Madras, made a presentation on Seismic safety and its promotion through the dissemination of Earthquake Tips.



During the year 3394 copies of books, monographs, and CDs, were distributed. To date, NICEE has distributed 2,08,870 such items.






#### **Earthquake Engineering Practice**

With a healthy growth of NICEE activities, the overall expenditure during the year stood at about ₹ 26.78 lakhs (₹ 27.27 lakhs last year). This was covered by a mix of resources from various sources: 6% from sales and fees, 54% from previous years' savings and 40% from interest from endowment. The sale proceeds from publications and monographs were ₹ 1.52 lakhs as compared to ₹ 1.80 lakhs last year. The number of donors this year is 59 (41 last year), contributing a total of ₹ 14.57 lakhs with an average donation of ₹ 24,700/- (₹ 5.68 lakh last year with an average of ₹ 13,846/-). Since its inception, NICEE has received one or more donations from a total of 572 donors with an overall median of ₹ 3,000; this is an excellent endorsement of NICEE's activities by its friends and well-wishers.




The prestigious World Conference on Earthquake Engineering (WCEE) is held every four years under the aegis of the International Association for Earthquake Engineering (IAEE) which are one of the largest technical/professional gatherings of various stakeholders engaged in promoting seismic safety across various disciplines and different parts of the World. The first conference was held in 1936 in California and the recent the 17th WCEE was held in Sendai, Japan in the hybrid mode due to Covid pandemic.

With advancements in technology and easy availability of computers and internet access, a need was strongly felt to make easy and free availability of all the papers presented in WCEE till date.

A project was, therefore, taken up by NICEE in 2010, and all the papers available till then were first uploaded on the website in December 2010. 5,360 papers from the first ten conferences (about 40,000 pages) had to be scanned for their use in the digitized library. As of date, there are more than 19,130 articles uploaded with about 160,000 pages (20 GB of Data). In order to ease the search, indices are built on the following attributes:



The graph below explains the worldwide access to WCEE papers with an average quarterly hit at present approx. 6700 with significant access in Asia and Europe which covers around - 88%; North America - 4.5%; South America - 3.5%; Australia – 3% and Africa - 1%.





To upload the proceedings of the recent 17th WCEE held at Sendai, Japan, we are making significant changes in the WCEE website, such as the migration of the entire WCEE website to a new platform and developing a webpage with an entirely new look and feel.
