# 1. Workshop for Under Graduate Architecture Students in Third Year

An online workshop for Architecture students was held at IIT Kanpur during August 07-14, 2021. This workshop was attended by 86 participants from Bhutan and 15 cities from all over India. Prof. Andrew Charleson gave the inaugural lecture.

During the eight-day workshop the students were asked to design Hostel Building for UG Students in a site in Almora, Uttarkhand, located in Seismic Zone V, with 1000+intake capacity.
