NICEE Newsletter: October 2011

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Details:

1. Sikkim Earthquake September 18, 2011

The M6.9 earthquake of Sikkim on 18th September 2011 caused widespread damage and destruction in Sikkim. Non-existent earthquake-resistant construction led to unacceptable level of damages to a large number of RC buildings. Such a performance for shaking intensity less than that expected in a design level earthquake indicates their high seismic vulnerability. Consequently, the seismic risk in the region is on rise with ever increasing inventory of seismically deficient constructions.

A team of IIT Kanpur (*Durgesh Rai*, *Goutam Mondal*, *Vaibhav Singhal*, *Neha Parool and Tripti Pradhan*) visited the earthquake-affected areas during Sept 28 - Oct 6 and later briefed the local community and media about their observations on performance of built-environment and lessons that can be learnt to mitigate the growing seismic risk in the region.
